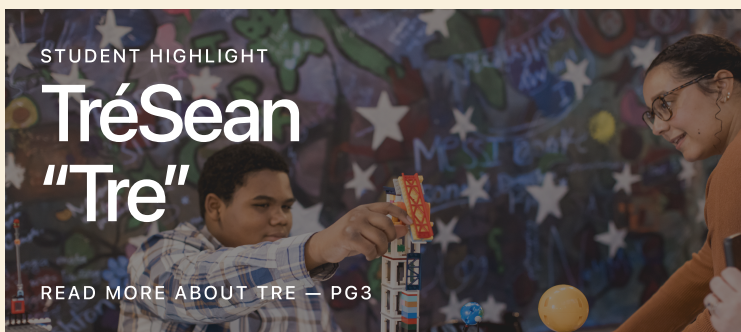

That memory returns to me when I look at the students we serve today. Brilliant young people navigating instability, pressure, and expectations that no child should have to balance. Children whose potential deserves to be nurtured, not overlooked.

Across the country, families are stretched thin.

Food is more expensive.

Childcare is harder to secure.

Transportation is unpredictable.

A lost paycheck can unravel everything.

And yet through all of this, children still have homework. They still have dreams. They still need backpacks, tutors, warm coats, hygiene products, technology, connection, and someone who believes their story isn't defined by their circumstances.

HCEF recognized 35 students and awarded \$85,500 – the most in the organization’s 26-year history – at the 11th Annual Hope Through Learning Awards (HTLA) luncheon. Named for HCEF's founder, the Joseph Lagana Perseverance Award of \$500 was presented to Jada Guiste, a HTLA past recipient who successfully graduated from post-secondary education.

HTLA supports students from Southwestern Pennsylvania who are enrolled in a post-secondary program. Applicants must have experienced homelessness or housing instability during school and may use the award for tuition, books, transportation, or childcare.

TréSean “Tre” is a bright and creative seventh grader at West Mifflin Middle School who excels in STEM subjects, especially mathematics and engineering. He has set goals for the school year, including earning an “A” in reading and language arts, reading for at least 20 minutes five days a week and completing the entire Percy Jackson series. He loves mastering algebra concepts and fractions and working with scientific notation in math.

During Tre’s HCEF tutoring sessions, he has continued to develop his word attack and vocabulary skills. He has also embraced free reading activities, showing special interest in air and space topics. And, Tre designs amusement park rides with Legos and stays active by playing tennis and soccer.

With career aspirations in architecture or engineering, Tre is already laying the foundation for a bright future.
